Mandate

To oversee the effective and transparent financial operations of the Foundation.

Composition

The Finance & Audit Committee shall consist of at least:

- the Chair of the Foundation Board,
- the Treasurer (who will act as Chair)
- at least 2 other Directors
- the President of the Foundation (ex-officio)

Responsibilities

In addition to the responsibilities of Board Director, the members of the Finance & Audit Committee are also responsible for the below.

- 1. Review for approval a detailed annual budget for capital and operating revenues and expenditures for the ensuing fiscal year.
- 2. Review for approval the quarterly financial statements of the Foundation.
- 3. Provide expertise on investment strategy, including allocation of investment funds.
- 4. Monitor and develop strategy around the health and maintenance of the unrestricted fund.
- 5. Review for approval all pledge write-offs annually.
- 6. Review the annual audited financial statements for approval by the Foundation Board.
- 7. Review and monitor compliance to the established Investment Policy and recommend any changes to the MGH Foundation Board of Directors for approval.
